

Who We Serve

Children ages 2-12 who have communication delays and learning differences, and often many other diagnoses. Our students typically have average to above-average learning potential, but struggle in a traditional school setting.

Admissions Process

- 1** 1.5 Hour Tour (Optional) Visit campus for an admissions presentation, Q&A and tour.
- 2** Application Submission and Review (\$50 Fee) Submit your application, supporting documentation and associated fee (fee due with application).
Recommendations are made to continue the admissions process or discuss other programs.
- 3** Screening (\$150 Fee) A Parish speech-language pathologist conducts a 30-minute, one-on-one session with your child. Afterwards, the speech-language pathologist meets with you to discuss the session. No formal report is provided.
Recommendations are made to continue the admissions process or discuss other programs.
- 4** Classroom Visit (\$200 Fee) Parish staff get to know your child over a two- to four-day visit. On the second day, observe your child in the classroom for an hour.
Parish staff involved in your child's admissions process determine if The Parish School is the best learning environment for your child.
- 5** Decision An admissions decision will be shared with families.

Application Requirements

Applicants are processed in order of their completed file and are accepted throughout the year.

Minimum requirements for early childhood students (ages 2-5):

- Application*
- Application Fee
- Early Childhood Questionnaire* (completed by your child's current teacher)
- Child Development Inventory*
- Speech-Language Evaluation (completed within last year)

Occupational therapy reports, medical evaluations, hearing and vision screenings, etc. are also helpful and accepted.

Minimum requirements for elementary students (ages 5-11):

- Application*
- Application Fee
- Elementary Questionnaire* (completed by your child's current teacher)
- Full Developmental or Neuropsychological Evaluation
 - Must include speech/language testing and cognitive achievement measures
 - Completed within the last two years by a neuropsychologist, developmental pediatrician or diagnostician (private or through your school district)
